



2021 Allotment Garden Agreement including COVID-19 mitigation

Welcome to the Albion Hills Community Farm Allotment Gardens. This agreement is for your safety and to keep the Allotment Gardens a welcoming and enjoyable place for all. By renting an Allotment Garden plot at Albion Hills Community Farm, you are accepting and making a commitment to abide by these rules.

- I will **not** come to the Farm if I have any symptoms of COVID-19 or if under self-isolation due to travel or contact with COVID-19.
- I agree to abide by restrictions imposed by the Ontario and Federal governments, Town of Caledon, Peel Public Health, TRCA and/or AHCF, even if I may not be able to harvest my crops.
- I will maintain the required physical distance, use the attendance record and be cautious when using common areas.
- I will enter the Farm during daylight only using the 16555 Humber Station Rd entrance.
- I will pay my plot rental by **Mar 15** by E-transfer to treasurer@albionhillscommunityfarm.org or by PayPal via the website.
- I will have something planted in my plot by **June 15th** and keep it planted all summer.
- If I must abandon my plot for any reason, I will notify the allotment garden coordinator.
- I will be welcoming and considerate to other allotment gardeners, staff and volunteers.
- I will use my own tools and hose to tend my own plot.
- I will not set any fires, use barbeques or have any open flames in the Allotment Gardens.
- I will keep weeds down and maintain the areas immediately surrounding my plot.
- If my plot becomes unkempt, I understand that I will be given a two-week notice to clean it up; after that time, it will be reassigned.
- I will clean up trash and litter on my plot, as well as from adjacent pathways and fences.
- I will remove all stakes and plant material from my plot prior to **November 1st** unless I have paid to retain my plot in the following year.
- I will participate in the fall clean-up of the garden as needed.
- I will plant tall crops only where they do not shade neighbouring plots and ensure that my plants do not grow beyond the boundaries of my plot.
- I will pick only my own crops unless given permission by the plot user.
- I will not use synthetic fertilizers, insecticides or weed killers.
- I will only use natural soil amendments (e.g. compost, manure, straw). I will contact the garden coordinator before using any soil or plant treatments.
- I will not allow pets or children to roam freely on the property.
- I will be water-conscious and will not leave water running when I am not present.
